#### **Program**

Title: Democracy and political communication – the role of social media.

**Short description:** 

This course aims to contribute to studying the relationship between communication and power, specifically the role of social media in the political scenario (political debate; politization; electoral campaigns; polarization).

The study of political phenomena today is directly linked to the workings, tools, and impact of the media, and the process of digitization and control of information is crucial to analyzing the workings of political systems and electoral processes.

In a period of propaganda, fake news, and post-truth, it is important to decode the concepts and understand the dynamics of how society works, with communication as a fundamental pillar.

To this end, the aim is to bring together experts from both areas (communication and political science) in a cooperative effort with students from the partner universities, in a process that includes both a theoretical and a practical dimension with a view to a detailed characterization of the challenges between media and politics.

The program is structured to take place hybrid, with 5 days in person and 12 hours online.

The program will include 20 students. We can accommodate a higher number, according to the availability or request of the partner institutions.

Proposed schedule: To build with partners.

Guests/speakers/experts (if any): The program will have the participation of 2/3 UBI professors and 4 guest speakers/professors/experts from other Portuguese universities and international partners.
