ART. 1 - SCOPE AND DESTINATION OF MOBILITY


The UNITA Project has among its key actions to enhance the international experience of its students through the implementation of mobilities that respect the quality requirements of the Erasmus Charter for Higher Education in all aspects related to the organization and management of mobility.

UNITA is composed of six comprehensive research universities from five countries:

- Universidade de Beira Interior (UBI) ;
- Universidad de Zaragoza (UNIZAR) ;
- Université Savoie Mont Blanc (USMB) ;
- Università di Torino (UniTO) ;
- Universitatea de Vest din Timișoara (UVT) ;
- Université de Pau et des Pays de l'Adour (UPPA).

In the framework of this action, the project "**UNITA - Rural Internship**" is created with the aim of opening mobility channels that reinforce the competences and improve the employability of university students. "UNITA - Rural Mobility" is a programme of university internships for UNITA-Universities Partner Students' in entities and companies in rural municipalities.

For the "UNITA - Rural Mobility" call proposed by Université de Pau et des Pays de l'Adour (UPPA) in 2023, in collaboration with our 9 local partners, there are 16 different offers for the internships, as follows :



ART. 3 – ELIGIBILITY REQUIREMENTS

Art. 4.1 - Academic requirements

UNITA students participating in the programme must be enrolled in the academic year 2022-2023, on the date of submission of applications, in official undergraduate (with at least 90 ECTS passed) or postgraduate degree programme or PhD at the Universities of the UNITA Consortium. This mobility is compatible with other international mobility programmes as long as the two mobility periods do not overlap.

Art. 3.2 - Language requirements

For applications to be valid, candidates must prove their level with at least:

• a B1 level of French, sometimes B2: See the expected level according to the internship offer in the Annexes.

UNITA students can prove their language level by presenting a language certificate according to the different options below:

- Free and quick placement test in French on UE Academy ;
- Certificate from your language teacher;
- Certificate of level of the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR);
- Valid international certificate.

ART. 4 - RECOGNITION OF ACADEMIC ACTIVITIES DURING MOBILITY

The "UNITA Rural Internship" program within the framework of the UNITA - Universitas Montium Alliance is considered as a training experience for the internationalization of the academic career.

In this regard, the recognition of the activities carried out during the mobility must be agreed upon by filling in the "Learning Agreement for UNITA Rural Internship".

The training activity can be recognized in ECTS according to the regulations of each home institution.


For the purpose of recognition and at the end of the UNITA Rural Internship, the student will be issued a **Certificate of Participation** signed by the host institution to guarantee that the student has been assiduous during the period of hosting. The recognition of this document is left to the discretion of the home university.

ART. 5 - TERMS OF RECEPTION AND FINANCIAL SUPPORT

Art. 5.1 - Hosting arrangements for local partners

The internship structures welcome the trainees according to different modalities depending on their capacity and means:

The GECT and the Château à Enigmes offer internships longer than 2 months. This means that the trainees are paid 560 € per month, based on a work week of 35 hours. These structures offer free accommodation on the spot or close to the place. The trainees are autonomous in buying food and cooking.





- The Château de Morlanne and the artistic association TRAM.E offer internships longer than 2 months. This means that the trainees are paid 560 € per month, based on a work week of 35 hours. These structures do not have accommodation to offer. This salary will allow the trainees to cover their expenses on accommodation and food. They are autonomous on these two aspects. The UPPA mobility manager, upon request, will be able to assist them in finding accommodation.
- Waste Me Up, InSite, La Soulane, the Mauléon-Licharre municipality and the Ossau Valley community of municipalities offer unpaid internships. On the other hand, interns are provided with free accommodation on site. In addition, the University of Pau and Pays de l'Adour can provide a "grant" to trainees to cover food expenses on the basis of 25 € per day (see next section).

Art. 5.2 - Financial support from UPPA

This section only concerns students who do an internship with **Waste Me Up**, **InSite**, **La Soulane**, **the Mauléon-Licharre municipality** or **the Ossau Valley community of communes**. There is an opportunity for the student to receive financial aid in the form of a grant to cover living expenses (food) that will be paid in one payment to the student directly, by bank transfer (to the student's IBAN account). The grant is calculated by multiplying the rural period of the internship by the amount of **25 € per day**. The **Convention de bourse de mobilité rurale** must be signed 2 weeks before the arrival in France and the bank transfer must be made within 10 calendar days after the signature of the agreement by both parties, and at the latest on the date of the beginning of the mobility period.

The financial aid is not intended to cover all expenses generated by the UNITA rural mobility. Any additional costs will have to be covered by the UNITA student by his/her own means.

ART. 6 - INSURANCE AND RESPONSABILITY

If UPPA manages to enroll its incoming students, this section will no longer be taken into account because UPPA will cover the student.

The participant must have adequate insurance coverage (health, travel, accident and civil liability, repatriation). It is the participant's responsibility to clearly inform him/herself about insurance issues. All information concerning insurance is entirely dependent on the legal and administrative provisions of the host country (France). The participant is responsible for signing any mandatory insurance before arriving in the host country. At the time of signing the *Convention de bourse de mobilité rurale*, the participant must provide proof of signing the insurance, valid for the whole period of mobility, according to the legal and administrative provisions of the host country.

ART. 7- APPLICATION PROCEDURE

The online application for this call will be open until March 31st March at 2:00 p.m (CET) None application will be allowed after this deadline.





After the expiry of the call deadline, the candidates of the University of Turin will be contacted by the UNITA Office of Turin. They will effectively have to complete a procedure for the evaluation of academic transcripts of records and the validation of applications.

All students must apply through an online application form.

The following documents must be attached to the application:

- CV in French (Europass CV appreciated) ;
- Academic transcript of records ;
- Enrolment certificate for the academic year 2022-2023 ;
- Language certificate (B1 en French) ;
- Letter of motivation in French (candidates should explain the reasons for applying, express their motivation and their academic objectives).

The submission of the application implies the acceptance of the conditions established in this call for applications and the authorisation delivered to the UPPA to verify the veracity of the necessary data in other institutions.

ART. 8- EVALUATION PROCEDURE

Phase 1 : First evaluation within UPPA

The UNITA office/International Relations office will check that applicants meet the requirements of the call for applications and that their documents comply with the inherent provisions. Incomplete applications will not be considered eligible.

Phase 2 : Final Evaluation by the hosting organisation

The final evaluation will be performed by the hosting organisation (local partner): the student's tutor him/herself. The local partner may require an additional interview with the applicant, either by phone or video conference

This procedure for this call for applications will be handled on a competitive basis and incompliance with the principles of publicity, objectivity, transparency, equity and non-discrimination.

The local partner will establish a list of selected students and a list of students on the waiting list that will be forwarded to the UNITA Mobility Manager.

ART. 9- – PUBLICATION, ACCEPTING/REFUSING THE MOBILITY

The decision on the awarding of the UNITA – Rural Mobility places will be published on the 26/04/2023 both on the UNITA and the UPPA websites, containing the final eligible candidate list and the waiting list in order of priority.

This publication will be considered as an official notification to the interested persons.

The students have 7 days, after the publication of the results, to accept or refuse the mobility. The final decision must be communicated to: <u>unita-mobilities@univ-pau.fr</u>. Those who do not



accept their mobility offer within the deadlines will automatically be excluded from the eligible candidate list.

ART. 10 - SCROLLING OF THE RANKING LIST

Places not filled due to non-acceptance or renunciation of the mobility or vacant place will be assigned by scrolling the ranking up to the start date of the internship period. In this case, the assignment of the mobility will be communicated to suitable candidates called in replacement only via the e-mail address indicated at the time of application.

ART. 11- RIGHTS AND DUTIES OF SELECTED STUDENTS

The selected trainees must comply with the following obligations:


- Maintain the confidentiality and professional ethics required during the internship

If UPPA manages to enroll its incoming students, this section will no longer be taken into account because UPPA will cover the student. Otherwise, the student will have to provide himself with :

- Accidents and liability insurance, including repatriation
- European Health Card or a private medical insurance (for non-EU citizens)

ART. 12- DATA PROTECTION


The UPPA will operate in accordance with the "Privacy Policy" regarding processing personal data, as per Art.13 of EU General Regulation 679/2016 on data protection.









ANNEXE 1_ Rural internship offer 2023_Cabanes suspendues










